

RRMS Writing Scores Among Highest in the State!

The instructional goal of Superintendent Mark Rains is for Dixie District Schools to meet or exceed the state average in test scores. Eighth grade students did exactly that this year on FCAT Writing. The state average for eighth grade students in writing this year was 4.0. Ruth Rains Middle School students averaged 4.6 on writing scores this year. Only two districts in the state averaged 4.6 on writing scores in the eighth grade: Dixie and Martin Counties. The only school scoring higher was FAU Lab School with a 4.7. Superintendent Rains is extremely proud of this accomplishment. The goal of meeting or exceeding the state average is known throughout the district. In fact, both the elementary schools and the high school nearly met the state average as all three schools averaged a 3.9 on writing scores. The state average for elementary and high schools was 4.0.
