Dixie District Schools Meal Charge Policy

Elementary Schools

Elementary School Students are allowed to charge up to 5 breakfast and lunches. If the negative balance is not paid when the charge limit is met, the student is offered an alternative meal.

Dixie School Food Service is allowing unlimited meal charges for elementary students; we send negative balance notes home with the students three (3) days per week.

Middle and High Schools

Dixie School Food Service allows the student to charge three lunch meals. No breakfast charges are allowed at the secondary schools. If the charge is not paid the student is offered an alternative meal, which consists of the “vegetable of the day” and a milk.

The cashier notifies the student when their balance reflects a low amount and when the students’ funds are depleted and the meal is debited to their account.

The meal charge policy is printed in all student handbooks. The information is also announced at Meet Your Teacher Night and Open House.
