

The School Messenger attendance call out program started on January 13, 2011 with calls made to parents when their student is absent from schools. Calls are made based on if your student is absent from school. This does include excused absences if you have already notified the school that your student will be absent. At the middle school and high school since attendance is taken by period, a parent will receive a call if the student is absent during any one period of the day. If we don't have a current phone number or address for you, please let your student's school know the most current information.

This program will be used to call homes in the event of a school closure or emergency situation, as well. We will be using it to notify you that the school district, in coordination with the Dixie County Emergency Services will be conducting a mock disaster drill during the month of January. In addition, the individual schools may use the program to notify you of events that are occurring at the school.
