

Public School Choice for Dixie County

Dixie County is a small rural district that consists of only one (1) school for grades 9-12 (Dixie County High School), one (1) school for grades 6-8 (Ruth Rains Middle School) and two (2) elementary schools grades Pre-K-5 (Anderson and Old Town). None of the schools in the district have made AYP for two consecutive years, so letters were sent requesting an agreement (May 4, 2011) to all surrounding districts superintendents (Levy, Taylor, Lafayette, Gilchrist) but none have agreed to accept Dixie District Students. The Dixie County LEA has not been able to offer PSC since 2006-07 school year when Taylor County allowed Dixie County students to attend Steinhatchee Elementary. Due to the lack of availability of schools, we have no Public School Choice (PSC) to offer our students at this time. Dixie District does not have any eligible receiver schools at this time.
